Footnotes

NATHANIEL stalked the pace off the rail, bid alongside a rival into the turn, took the lead nearing the stretch, inched away past midstretch and held gamely under urging. WARREN'S TOMMY TOO angled in and stalked the pace inside, came out into the stretch and continued willingly to the wire. WHO'S YOUR WIDADY chased off the inside then outside on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and picked up the show. PRINCE NOVETTI saved ground off the pace, came out some in the stretch, split horses in deep stretch and lacked the needed late kick. SERIOUS FORM sped to the early lead, set the pace off the rail then angled in, fought back along the fence into and on the turn and until midstretch and weakened in the final furlong. CASA O angled in and stalked outside then alongside a rival, came out into the stretch and lacked a further response. BERNSIE'S BABY settled between horses or a bit off the rail, swung four wide into the stretch and was not a threat. UNUSUAL JUSTIN came in early, chased three deep or off the rail, angled in some on the turn and did not rally. PHILLY SLEW steadied after the start and fell back, settled outside or off the rail, came out in the stretch and failed to menace. CALL ME HONCHO broke slowly, came off the rail then went up outside on the backstretch, continued three deep on the turn, fell back nearing the stretch and weakened.
