Footnotes

GILLIGAN sped to the early lead a bit off the rail, angled to the inside around the first turn, set moderate fractions while clear down the backstretch, was put to left handed urging in midstretch and drew out in the final furlong under a long hold late. BOULDER CREEK was bumped at the start, chased outside a rival down the backstretch, engaged COURTSIDE ACTION at the top of the lane, battled outside that rival the length of the stretch and won the battle for second while no threat to the winner. COURTSIDE ACTION broke awkwardly and veered out at the start, bumped BOULDER CREEK, recovered to be closest to the winner down the backstretch, was asked for his best leaving the quarter pole, battled inside BOULDER CREEK the length of the stretch and was edged for the place by that rival. ROYAL IMPORT (GB) was bumped at the start, settled at the back of the pack down the backstretch and around the second turn, swung widest in the drive and lacked the necessary rally. TIS bobbled slightly and was bumped at the start, pulled while inside horses around the first turn, settled on the inside down the backstretch, weakened on the second turn and gave way through the stretch drive.
