LORD AVALON chased off the rail then outside on the turn, came into the stretch three deep, gained the lead under urging three wide a sixteenth out, inched away and held gamely. BELO PURSE (BRZ) broke inward, settled off the inside then angled in some leaving the backstretch, came out leaving the turn and three wide into the stretch and finished well. SETH THE CANDEYMAN prompted the pace three deep then outside a rival, took the advantage into the stretch, battled between foes a sixteenth out and held third. DON ELIAS M. (MEX) had good early speed and dueled between horses then a bit off the rail into the turn, angled to the inside leaving the turn, fought back in the stretch and weakened late. SWONGS broke a bit slowly and was squeezed back, settled off the rail, came a bit wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. WILD HOMBRE sent along inside to press the pace, stalked along the rail on the turn and weakened in the stretch. FULL ON stalked a bit off the rail then came out leaving the backstretch, continued outside on the turn, angled in some into the stretch, was between horses in upper stretch and also weakened.
