**Footnotes**

NO AFFILIATION stalked outside a rival, bid alongside a foe on the turn, took the lead a quarter mile out, inched away into the stretch, kicked clear in the drive and held under urging. MILLIE N MARIE close up stalking the pace inside, came out a bit leaving the turn and into the stretch and finished well. TAKETHEMONEYANDRUN between horses early, chased outside then three deep into the turn, angled to the inside leaving the turn, came out in midstretch and clearly bested the rest. CLUBHOUSE RULES broke out and a bit awkwardly, settled off the rail, went outside rivals on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and improved position. DIAMOND JOURNEY broke a bit slowly, went outside a rival then between horses leaving the backstretch, steadied in tight into the turn, came out some in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. GLADIATRIX a bit slow into stride, was sent up inside to gain the lead, set the pace along the rail, duelled inside the winner on the turn and weakened in the stretch. ROULETTE IT ROLL chased outside then four wide leaving the backstretch, came three deep into the stretch and lacked a further response. NOISE OF THE CROWD chased between horses then off the rail on the turn and into the stretch and weakened. COY PRINCESS between rivals early, chased inside, dropped back on the turn and also weakened. MISS MARSHA LEE stalked between horses, steadied in tight into the turn, was pulled up early on the turn and vanned off.
