Footnotes

HE'S VERY RARE sped to the early lead and angled in, set a pressured pace inside, inched away leaving the second turn, came a bit off the rail into the stretch, fought back under urging between foes in midstretch and toward the rail in the late stages and held on gamely. DYLAN DONNELLY between horses early, chased outside a rival, ranged up three deep leaving the second turn and into the stretch, bid three wide in midstretch then continued outside the winner late and went on willingly but was outgamed. JONNY'S CHOICE three deep into the first turn, angled in and saved ground stalking the pace, bid along the rail in the drive, could not match the top pair late but clearly bested the others. HUNTSVILLE four wide into the first turn, angled in and bid alongside the winner to press the pace, stalked between horses leaving the second turn, dropped back into the stretch, drifted in some and weakened. ELUSIVE JOURNEY pulled his way along inside then chased a bit off the rail, dropped back on the backstretch, found the fence again on the second turn and lacked a response in the stretch. NO LOOKIN' BACK unhurried and angled in early, saved ground off the pace throughout and failed to menace. DYLAN DONNELLY, JONNY'S CHOICE and HUNTSVILLE wore calks.
