Footnotes

PLEASURE TO RIDE sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, dueled on the backstretch and second turn, inched away a bit off the rail in midstretch and held on gamely under urging. PATCH OF BLUE pulled his way along a bit off the rail then between horses, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and gained the place. FIRE BREAK saved ground stalking the pace, continued inside on the second turn and through the stretch and edged rivals for third. BIG WIG between horses early, stalked outside a rival, was three deep leaving the second turn and into the stretch and was edged for the show. SQUALLCREEK broke in a bit, stalked early then bid alongside the winner and dueled for the lead, was between horses in midstretch and weakened some in the final furlong. MY MAN MURF close up stalking the pace a bit off the rail or inside, was between rivals leaving the second turn and weakened in the lane. ZAPPA was a step slow to begin and squeezed a bit, chased three deep, dropped back off the rail on the second turn and had little left for the stretch.
