MR GRUFF a bit slow to begin, pulled his way along inside stalking the pace, came out into the stretch, gained the lead alongside the runner-up in midstretch and won clear under a left handed crack of the whip, steady handling and a long hold late. PRAIRIE CITY ROAD sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail then inside, battled along the fence in midstretch, could not match the winner thereafter but was clearly second best. KELLY LEAK settled outside then off the rail, angled in on the hill, came out into the stretch, was bumped in upper stretch and picked up the show. TRES BORRACHOS stalked off the rail then outside a rival, came out some in the stretch and weakened. PEACE CHANT settled three deep then outside a rival chasing the pace, came out leaving the hill and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. PAPA BEAR broke a bit slowly, saved ground chasing the pace and did not rally. NEW BAY pulled his way along outside then between foes, steadied behind a rival on the hill, continued outside a foe, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. CANDY PULL stalked outside a rival then off the rail, broke down and was pulled up between foes on the hill and vanned off. Rail on hill at 14 feet.
