Footnotes

RHYTHM OF LIFE (GB) angled over and assumed control leaving the initial turn, controlled the pace from just off the rail, edged away into the lane and desperately held despite drifting out late. FUN HOUSE caught three wide around both turns, chased the winner into the stretch and whittled gap considerably nearing the wire. NATURALLY WILD settled between foes, raced on three wide trip into and around the final turn, then four wide into the stretch and gained third. ILE DE FRANCE settled just off the pace while saving ground, between foes into the lane and through the drive and improved placing. SHALINI reserved off the pace, raced on three wide path around both bends and finishing willingly. LAST TANGO (IRE) unhurried from along the fence, came out late on the final turn, raced three wide into the stretch and closed ground. BAIL BOND was a bit washy, chased from along the rail, continued inside and lost placing through the drive. GO ON BABY tracked the pacesetter from off the rail, but dropped back readily around the second turn and through the lane.
