HOLIDAY FUN broke slowly, moved up inside on the backstretch, stalked outside a rival on the turn, came in onto that one into the stretch, bid along the rail, took the lead past the eighth pole and pulled clear under urging. TIME AGAIN dueled between horses on the backstretch and inside a foe but off the rail on the turn, battled outside the winner in midstretch, could not match that one but was clearly second best. RICKY J bumped between horses at the start, angled in on the backstretch, moved up inside leaving the turn, came out into the stretch and picked up the show. KISSTHESTARGOODBY had good early speed and dueled inside, stalked along the rail on the turn, was in a bit tight at the quarter pole, steadied sharply behind the winner into the stretch and lacked a further response. DEMONIC STORM forced the pace three deep on the backstretch and outside the runner-up on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and weakened. INCAPER broke slowly, settled a bit off the rail, was roused leaving the backstretch and did not rally. FEEL THE CHARM bumped at the break, chased outside then alongside a rival early on the turn, continued off the rail and weakened. FOREVER AMERICAN bumped at the start, was between horses then outside the winner on the backstretch chasing the pace, continued off the rail on the turn, came wide into the stretch and had little left. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the stretch run between the first and fourth place finishers but made no change when they ruled the trouble to the latter did not alter the original order of finish.
