Footnotes

FOG ALERT chased outside a rival then just off the rail, swung out into the stretch, bid outside foes to gain the lead past midstretch and won clear under left handed urging. THEY CALL HIM EL angled in on the first turn and saved ground off the pace, moved up inside leaving the second turn and into the stretch, came out in midstretch and just gained the place. VERY FAIR between horses early, angled in and stalked inside then a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch, bid between horses past the eighth pole and was edged late for the place. ROMAN GUITAR sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, drifted out into the stretch, drifted inward under urging and took an awkward step nearing midstretch and weakened in the final furlong. MICHAEL THE MAN pulled early and drifted out into the first turn, settled inside, came out on the second turn and alongside a rival nearing the stretch and lacked the needed rally. TIME FOR ATONEMENT pulled between horses into the first turn, stalked between foes then off the rail, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. BRADY BLUE EYES four wide into the first turn, stalked three deep then outside a rival, dropped back out from the rail leaving the second turn and into the stretch and had little left for the drive. KEEN BIDDER (GB) five wide into the first turn, chased outside then off the rail, fell back into and on the second turn, gave way and was eased in the stretch. ROMAN GUITAR wore calks.
