Footnotes

HICKORY PETE forwardly placed from off the fence, advanced three wide on the turn, split foes on same path into the lane, forged to the front and pulled clear under urging. NEWPORT GREEN broke out slightly, moved up and bid three deep midway on the bend, drifted out entering the stretch and outside the winner, then gamely prevailed for second. CHEROKEE BENGE pressed the early pace outside rival, gained slim lead approaching stretch, raced lost command inside winner into the stretch and earned a share of the show. PATRIOT'S PASS unhurried while angling in some and saved ground to the stretch, then shifted out in upper stretch and again inside eighth marker and reached even terms for third from far outside. STREET THEATRE reserved while finding the fence, saved ground to the stretch, angled out through the lane and just missed third. SEA KRIS was slow into stride, saved ground into the turn while unhurried, later split foes and improved placing. BARBARIAN chased from far outside, continued four wide around the bend and into the lane and lacked an effective rally. CORONADO'S PRIDE set a pressured pace outside the backstretch, dueled inside rival late on the turn, then lost contact with leaders and gave way. COME OUT SMOKIN' angled in some, chased outside rival on the turn and never menaced. CHAUNCEY prominent early from the inside, raced on two wide path into the stretch, swung out and weakened.
