TENT (IRE) pulled his way along to stalk the pace inside, awaited room in upper stretch, got through along the rail to gain the lead past midstretch and proved best under a tap with the whip turned down, some hand urging and a snug hold late. VICTORY VOODOO pulled his way to the early lead outside a rival, inched away briefly and angled in on the first turn, set a pressured pace inside, edged away again into the stretch, came off the rail in the drive and held second between foes late. PROPAGANDA three deep early, chased a bit off the rail, found the inside leaving the second turn and gained the show along the fence. CINDER CONE pulled between horses then pressed the pace inside, continued alongside the runner-up on the backstretch and second turn and was edged for a minor award three deep on the line. HOUSE OF SILVER pulled early, stalked outside a rival then between foes on the second turn, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. FARLEIGH HOUSE a bit slow to begin, settled inside then outside a rival, went three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response.
