Footnotes

BIKINI BOTTOM bobbled, veered in and bumped a rival at the start, stalked a bit off the rail down the backstretch and inside a foe around the turn, came into the stretch between horses, took a short lead at the top of the lane and held her foes safe to the wire. RICH IN TRADITION stalked three deep on the backstretch and outside the winner on the turn, came into the lane three wide, kept to her task through the drive and was a clear second at the wire. DULCEMIA was bumped at the start, angled off the rail on the backstretch, moved closer on the outside around the turn and rallied to gain the show. PROUD BOK chased off the inside throughout and lacked the necessary rally in the lane. SWEET IRISH LASS was bumped between horses at the start, moved up quickly to gain the early lead, set the pace to the lane and weakened on the inside through the final furlong. SIMPLY SECRET was hustled from the gate, stalked between horses on the backstretch, dropped back into the turn and weakened in the lane. POPPY LOVE angled in on the backstretch, saved ground around the turn, came out in the lane and gave way.
