ONE FAST FROG sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, fought back along the fence under urging in the stretch to regained the advantage in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. PEPPY BOLLY stalked three deep on the backstretch, bid alongside the winner on the turn, took a short lead into the stretch, battled alongside that rival through the drive and was outgamed late. SWEET NECTAR was in a good position stalking the pace between horses on the backstretch and again on the turn, outfinished the others for third. FRENCH CURLS broke alertly then saved ground off the pace, continued inside on the turn and in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MAGESTIC STINGER between foes early, saved ground stalking the pace, came out some in upper stretch and weakened. SAMURAI JESS bobbled in an awkward start when breaking splay legged, chased outside a rival then three deep on the turn and into the stretch and lacked a response in the drive.
