Footnotes

CLEARLY CONFUSED bobbled in a bit of a slow start, settled inside, came out on the turn and three deep into the stretch, rallied under urging while drifting in to gain the lead passing the sixteenth pole and won clear. SUGAR SPICE had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away on the turn, kicked clear, was not a match for the winner in the final sixteenth but held second. ZEES CHRIS chased off the rail then a bit off the fence on the turn and into the stretch and just held third. ADDENDUM settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail, found the fence into the turn, continued inside in the stretch and was edged for the show. MY BRITE CAROLINE chased off the rail or outside a rival, dropped back on the turn and weakened. VINDICTED RULER sped to the early lead, dueled outside the runner-up, stalked off the rail on the turn, drifted out some into the stretch and also weakened.
