Footnotes

STAR'S MILLENNIUM settled outside foe into the backstretch, angled to the rail midway on final bend, rallied inside TIZZIFIED to grab command and drew clear despite drifting out a bit late. KALIHI MAGGIE reserved off the fence, advanced three wide around the final turn, forced four wide into the stretch and gained the place from the outside. MARY MOSCOW tracked the early leaders while saving ground, loomed three wide entering the stretch and gamely gained the show. BIMBO'S KISS settled outside rival early, veered inward nearing five-eighths marker and checked off heels, continued to save ground into the lane and finished willingly. TIZZIFIED taken off the rail and advanced to engage the pacesetter early on the backstretch, inherited clear lead leaving the backstretch, drifted out late on final bend and weakened. FOLLOW MY HEINEKEN reserved along the rail into backstretch, later avoided fallen horse and never reached serious contention. CLEARED TO LAND stalked the early leaders on a two wide path, dropped back on the second turn, then was eased and walked off. CONTINENTAL MISS stepped to the front and dictated early pace while a bit rank, dueled along the rail approaching the final turn, veered inward, hit the rail and unseated rider. A stewards inquiry into the incident into the second turn did not change the results since CONTINENTAL MISS was ruled to make her own trouble while racing in the clear.
