COMMANDER'S FLAG content to lag back while gradually angling to the rail, advanced inside on the turn, swung out entering the stretch and overhauled rivals under strong hand urging. SEATTLE SHAMUS forced the pace on a two wide path into the lane, loomed passing midstretch and garnered the place from between foes. HURRICANE SMOKE sped to the front and controlled the pace a bit off the fence, continued inside, dug in through the final eighth but was collared. POHAVE chased from off the fence leaving the backstretch, drifted out further entering the stretch and raced a bit erratic through the lane. VODKA AND TONIC had a rail-hugging trip and weakened in the late stages. NOVWAR settled off the pace, raced three wide into the bend, dropped back readily, then was eased late in the stretch and walked off.
