BOULE D'OR (IRE) broke a bit slowly, pulled his way up three deep on the hill, took the lead outside the runner-up in the stretch the first time, angled in and opened a lengthy advantage into the clubhouse turn, widened the advantage on the backstretch, continued inside in the stretch and just held on under urging. PORFIDO (CHI) took the early lead and angled in, surrendered the front in the stretch the first time, chased inside, came out in midstretch and rallied between foes late. WARNING ZONE stalked a bit off the rail early then chased inside, came out on the second turn and into the stretch and finished with interest three deep on the line. FITZ FLAG (ARG) steadied at the start, settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail, went three deep on the final turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. OBRIGADO (FR) saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. ON THE ACORN (GB) allowed to settle a bit off the rail, chased outside a rival then between foes on the last turn, found the inside in the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. BABY FIRST (FR) squeezed a bit at the start, chased the pace along the inside, remained on the rail in the stretch and had no response in the drive. Rail on hill at zero.
