Footnotes

PURE STORM was caught three wide into the first turn, chased off the rail down the backstretch, bid for the lead approaching the quarter pole, took command at the top of the stretch, inched clear and drew out in the final furlong under urging. MUSICAL GRACE sped to the lead on the inside into the first turn, opened up a clear lead on the backstretch, was challenged for command leaving the second turn, weakened through the lane but was a clear second at the wire. MEMO TO KATHY went around the first turn four wide, chased on the outside down the backstretch and three wide around the second turn, remained outside for the drive and gained the show on the wire. SI MAR'S DEAR hopped slightly at the start, raced into the first turn between horses, stalked off the rail down the backstretch, saved some ground around the second turn, weakened in the lane and lost the show on the wire. SEXY MELODY saved ground around the first turn, chased on the inside throughout and failed to mount a rally. WARREN'S MYSTERY angled over to save some ground around the first turn, chased a bit off the rail down the backstretch, swung out in the lane and did not improve her position.
