### Footnotes

TROIS AUREOLE pulled her way along three deep and was in a bit tight on the first turn, chased outside a rival, came out leaving the second turn, was fanned five wide into the stretch, gained the advantage under left handed urging in midstretch, drifted inward in the final furlong but won clear. CAVALLETTA also pulled early when outside foes, bid three deep on the backstretch, stalked off the rail on the second turn, was fanned four wide into the stretch, re-bid between foes in the drive, also drifted in and was second best. SELLERIA tugged hard under a hold and came out on the first turn, stalked outside a rival then a bit off the rail leaving the second turn, bid inside in the stretch and picked up the show. POPPY FIELD dueled inside, fought back on the second turn, was between horses in midstretch and weakened. ROYALE LEGACY between horses early, angled in and chased inside then a bit off the rail, went outside a rival on the second turn, came out into the stretch, steadied off heels then angled inward in midstretch and lacked the needed rally. I'M ALWAYS HOPEFUL pulled between rivals and was in a bit tight off heels on the first turn, stalked inside, came out in midstretch and could not summon the necessary response. CALL ME LUCY unhurried and angled in early, settled a bit off the rail then inside, came out in the stretch and was not a threat. D'PRINCESS drifted out into the first turn, dueled outside a rival then between horses, fought back alongside a foe on the second turn, drifted out again into the stretch and weakened.
