CENTRALINTELLIGENCE had speed between foes then stalked outside a rival, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch, gained the lead nearing midstretch, inched away under left handed urging while drifting in and held. SAHARA SKY settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail, came out on the turn and also swung four wide into the stretch and finished willingly. CLASSIC LEGACY saved ground chasing the pace, came out off heels for room nearing midstretch and picked up the show. STACY'S HOPE chased outside a rival or off the rail, angled out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. C J RUSSELL had speed off the rail then angled in and dueled inside, fought back on the turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. LEGAL SEPARATION saved ground stalking the pace, came out on the turn and three deep into the stretch, was between foes in midstretch and lacked the necessary response. ANTHONY'S CROSS bobbled a bit at the start, dueled three deep then outside a rival, was between horses ion midstretch and weakened.
