**Footnotes**

WE HAVE LIFT OFF sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, turned back a pair of bids leaving the backstretch, kicked clear on the second turn, came a bit off the rail into the stretch, drifted in and held on gamely under urging. ROMAN TIZZY saved ground off the pace, went outside a rival leaving the backstretch, advanced three deep on the second turn and into the stretch, also drifted in some and held second. GENTLEMEN PETE bumped at the start, settled inside, moved up along the rail on the second turn and into the stretch, came out in upper stretch and finished well. STREET MAVEN broke in and bumped a rival, saved ground chasing the pace, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. FEARSOME CHARISMA broke a bit slowly, angled in and saved ground unhurried, continued inside on the second turn and in the stretch and improved position. SATCH chased outside or off the rail, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SENOR PEGASUS had speed three deep then stalked outside, bid three wide on the backstretch, fell back some between foes on the second turn and weakened. WISTFULLEE MINE had speed between foes then stalked off the rail, bid between rivals on the backstretch, steadied in tight and dropped back on the second turn and gave way. DICKERY DO chased outside then alongside a rival, dropped back on the second turn and had nothing left for the stretch.
