BUFFYTHECENTERFOLD advanced and engaged the pace while caught four deep into the turn, forged to the front and angled in to secure the front, surrendered the lead passing the eighth marker but battled back tenaciously to narrowly decision rival. WATCHING YOU content to settle well off the leaders, advanced four wide on turn during a prolonged rally, continued outside into the stretch, reached the front and gained nearly a length advantage but was outgamed to the wire. TAVY'S PLAN dueled three deep and inside the eventual winner leaving the backstretch, checked momentarily midway on that bend, weakened but proved next best. CHRISTMAS TIME contested the pace from between foes and on a two wide path into and around the turn, lost contact with the leaders, then angled to the fence and weakened. POINT CLEAR was sent up inside to join the leaders from along the rail, dropped back around the turn and gave way readily. A claim of foul by the rider of TAVY'S PLAN against the rider of BUFFYTHECENTERFOLD for alleged interference on the turn was not allowed by the stewards.
