COSTUME (GB) pulled her way to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, kicked clear under urging a bit off the rail in the stretch, drifted out under a left handed crack of the whip in deep stretch to brush with the runner-up nearing the wire and held on gamely between foes. IMMORTELLE (BRZ) chased outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and rallied between horses while brushing with the winner late. LAVENDER SKY chased inside then a bit off the rail, went outside a rival into the second turn, swung four wide into the stretch and finished well outside horses. FOXYSOX (GB) angled in and settled inside, came out for room into the stretch, waited a bit off heels then split rivals in midstretch and finished with interest inside. KRIS' SIS prompted the pace outside the winner then stalked off the rail, was between horses through the final furlong and was outfinished. PERSIAN EXPRESS a bit slow to begin, settled outside a rival or a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late response. COLINA VERDE (BRZ) angled in and stalked the winner inside to the stretch, remained inside and lacked the needed rally. I CAN SEE saved ground off the pace, moved up into the stretch, was in a bit tight along the rail past midstretch, came out and was not a threat. A claim of foul by the rider of the runner-up against the winner for alleged interference in deep stretch was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled the minor incident occurred too late to alter the original order of finish.
