STORM SAGA angled in and stalked the leaders, split foes early on final turn, waited for room approaching the stretch, swung out for room, rallied five wide and was along in time from outside. BEL SERENATA settled from outside, raced three wide into the second turn, four wide into the stretch, challenged in midstretch and gamely secured the place. CAMPAIGN ANDOVER dueled from along the rail to the final turn, drifted out slightly entering the stretch and battled bravely to the wire. HANSEL'S STAR stalked the leaders while saving ground, waited room room on the second turn, slipped through inside CAMPAIGN ANDOVER into the lane but failed to sustain bid. INTRODUCER well positioned outside HANSEL'S STAR early, loomed boldly while three deep around the final bend but then weakened. T. C.'S OATAY forced the early pace outside rival, bid between rivals around the final bend but came up empty in the drive. BELLE MICHELLE was slow into stride, lagged back while saving ground and failed to menace. NEAR BETHANY was off slow, settled outside rival, then raced four wide into the final turn and never reached contention. BUFFALO between horses and very rank into the initial turn, lagged back from far outside to the second turn, lugged out and was outrun.
