**Footnotes**

BROOKER B. TEE was off alertly, gained an early advantage and held despite drifting out through the final sixteenth. RENTS DUE was also off alertly, dueled from the inside, continued evenly in deep stretch and gamely held the place. DOUBLE D APPEAL was off a step slow, quickly recovered, moved up from between rivals and was getting to the runner-up late. BULITA veered in early, was straightened away and finished with interest from between horses. WILD HUMOR came in slightly early, then finished evenly from the outside. WEYBRIDGE came in shortly after the break, then weakened while a bit off the rail. HOPE RIVER broke inward, was straightened away and failed to threaten. SHEILA'S DESTINY was off a bit slow, came in slightly in the early going and lacked any late response. SURVIVING LADY drifted out passing the sixteenth marker and steadily weakened. STUKATZ was slow into stride, then gradually weakened. NO BLINKERS WERE WORN AND NO WHIPS WERE ALLOWED.
