Footnotes

DYNAMIC HOST settled a bit off the rail, advanced four wide then three deep leaving the backstretch, bid alongside a rival on the final turn, took a short lead nearing midstretch, inched clear under urging past midstretch and held gamely. DHAAMER (IRE) settled a bit off the rail then outside a rival, split foes then angled in and waited briefly off heels into the final turn, came out leaving that turn and three deep into the stretch, bid alongside the winner past midstretch and continued willingly but could not get by. SKIPSHOT dueled inside then stalked, re-bid along the rail leaving the backstretch and took a short lead, dueled inside on the last turn and in the stretch, weakened in the final furlong but clearly bested the others. ELDAAFER chased outside a rival or off the rail, came out around a foe on the final turn then angled in some and lacked a response in the stretch. GRAEME CRACKERJACK settled a bit off the rail then outside a rival, came out into the stretch and had little left for the drive. TWICE THE APPEAL pulled inside then came out on the first turn, tugged his way up to duel three deep then outside a rival, steadied between horses into the last turn and gave way. COLUDA dueled outside a rival then between foes, dropped back fast on the last turn, gave way and was eased in the stretch. HIGHWAY BANDIT pulled his way along inside, came off the rail into the backstretch, went three deep approaching the final turn, also gave way readily and was eased in the stretch.
