SUMERIAN pulled some and stalked inside, was in a bit tight between rivals leaving the backstretch, split horses a quarter mile out, angled in and bid inside to take the lead in upper stretch and held on gamely under urging. JUST FISHIN tugged his way up three deep to vie for the lead, put a head in front on the backstretch, dueled outside a rival, inched away on the second turn, fought back alongside the winner through the stretch and went willingly to the wire. COPPER BAY broke out a bit then came in onto a foe, stalked outside a rival, went three deep into and on the second turn and into the stretch and bested the others. ON HOLY GROUND between foes early, chased outside a rival then off the rail on the second turn and lacked a rally in the stretch. CARAMS saved ground off the pace, came out around a rival into the stretch and was not a threat. DYNAMIZE broke slowly, pulled his way along to bid between horses and dueled for the lead, battled inside leaving the backstretch and into the second turn, dropped back some leaving that turn and weakened. TRIPLE JEOPARDY pulled to the early lead, dueled inside, stalked leaving the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn and gave way. BIARCHY broke slowly and steadied when crowded, was rank under a hold and steadied again in the stretch the first time, chased outside a rival, dropped back leaving the backstretch, was pulled up on the second turn and vanned off.
