Footnotes

CHINESE PRAISE sent along inside to duel for the lead, put a head in front leaving the turn and held on gamely through a stiff drive under urging. WARREN'S DR. BOO sped to the early lead off the rail, angled in and dueled between horses, fought back between rivals through the drive and continued willingly to the wire. KURO a bit awkwardly into stride, stalked early then went up three deep to press the pace, continued prompted the issue three wide throughout and also went on gamely to the end. VALEN stalked three deep then outside a rival, angled to the inside on the turn, came out into the stretch and again in upper stretch and went on willingly to close the gap to the top trio. SECRET JACKPOT chased between horses then a bit off the rail on the turn, angled inward in the stretch and could not quite summon the necessary late kick. DANGER RANGER between foes early, stalked a bit off the rail, came out on the turn, fell back outside a rival leaving the turn, angled out into the stretch and weakened.
