Footnotes

REAL CONUNDRUM settled inside then a bit off the rail, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch, came out again in midstretch and rallied under left handed urging to get up on the wire. MASTER CHEF had good early speed and angled in, dueled inside, fought back into the stretch, kicked clear past midstretch and continued willingly but was caught on the line. JUSTIFICATION chased outside a rival on the backstretch and turn, came three wide into the stretch and finished willingly to best the rest. OBSESS sent inside early, chased just off the rail, came out into the stretch and lacked a rally in the drive. ISLAND SUNSET dueled three deep on the backstretch and most of the turn, battled outside the runner-up leaving the turn and into the stretch, fought back to midstretch and weakened in the final furlong. RED DEFENSE saved ground chasing the pace, came out some into the stretch, drifted in and did not rally. FREE TIME dueled between horses, fell back leaving the turn and had little left for the stretch.
