WARREN'S PEACOCK had speed five wide then three deep into the first turn, dueled outside a rival then inched away leaving that turn, set the pace a bit off the rail, kicked clear and angled in on the second turn and proved best under some left handed urging. REAL ROCKPORT angled in and chased a bit off the rail then outside on the backstretch, went three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and picked up the place. ZEES CHRIS chased three deep then outside a rival, went up three wide on the second turn, angled in some entering the stretch and bested the others. TOSCANOVA broke in a bit, had good early speed inside and dueled along the rail, saved ground stalking the pace on the backstretch and second turn and weakened in the stretch. WARREN'S JAZZ WALK pulled between horses and steadied in the run to the first turn, chased a bit off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch, drifted in late and lacked a response in the lane. LOUISA L. K. was in a good position stalking the pace outside a rival fell back in the stretch and weakened. LITTLE MOKUSH bobbled at the start, angled in and stalked inside then a bit off the rail, dropped back between horses early on the second turn and gave way.
