**Footnotes**

HALFAPONDAROSA chased off the rail down the backstretch, angled over to save ground around the turn, bid between horses in midstretch, took the lead and proved best. LUNCH TIME DIVA was hustled out of the gate, pressed the pace on the outside, dueled outside a rival into and around the turn, inched clear leaving the turn, drifted out in the final furlong but held the place. LILLY'S PERFECT chased on the outside down the backstretch and around the turn, came into the lane four wide, angled in through the final furlong and gained the show on the wire. SALTY SARAH stalked on the inside down the backstretch, angled out into the turn, came into the stretch three wide, was in a bit close off heels past the eighth pole, could not mount the necessary rally and was edged for the show on the wire. HIGH RESOLVE moved up between horses to take the early lead, dueled on the inside into and around the turn, could not match strides with her pace rival at the top of the lane and weakened on the inside through the final furlong.
