CAPTURE THE CALL had speed outside a rival then angled in and dueled inside, inched away a half mile out, continued clear in midstretch, drifted out some from the whip in the final furlong but held. MORGANOUSKA chased inside then came off the rail into the backstretch, went three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and finished willingly. NO STADIUM settled just off the rail then chased inside, came out into the stretch, went around a rival in midstretch then continued on well along the fence late. LIQUID ASSET prompted the pace three deep into and on the first turn, took back and stalked inside on the backstretch and second turn, remained along the rail in the stretch and weakened. KWIK broke a bit slowly, pulled a bit and chased off the rail, came a bit wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. ELUSIVE SCHEMES also a bit slow to begin, pulled his way between horses then dueled alongside the winner, stalked into the second turn, continued between foes on that turn and had little left for the drive.
