TIZ LIBERTY pulled his way along inside to duel for the lead, put a head in front on the second turn, kicked clear under urging nearing midstretch and drew off under left handed pressure. ROCKET ROAN angled in early then came out into the backstretch, chased a bit off the rail then outside a rival on the second turn, came out four wide leaving that turn and into the stretch, was three deep in midstretch and clearly second best. BELO PURSE (BRZ) bobbled slightly and broke in a bit, was between foes early then chased a bit off the rail, found the inside on the second turn and into the stretch and picked up the show. HAMMURABI pulled his way along three deep then dueled outside a rival, fought back on the second turn, was between foes in midstretch and weakened. MILES HEIR five wide early, went three deep into the first turn then chased alongside a foe, came three wide into the stretch and gave way. ALL MY CHIPS pulled between horses in the run to the first turn then stalked a bit off the rail, found the inside on the second turn, split rivals into the stretch and had little left for the drive.
