Footnotes

BOURBON BAY chased between horses on the first turn then angled in through the stretch the first time, came out a bit on the final turn, entered the stretch alongside a rival, angled out in the drive and closed willingly under some urging with the whip turned down and energetic handling to get up on the wire. SLIM SHADEY (GB) a bit fractious in the gate, tugged his way along three deep on the first turn, stalked off the rail then outside a rival, bid three wide into and on the last turn and into the stretch, put a head in front in midstretch, inched away a sixteenth out, drifted in then out some from the whip and held on well but was caught on the line. HOG'S HOLLOW sped to the early lead then set a comfortable pace along the inside under a rating hold, fought back along the fence on the final turn and a bit off the rail in the stretch, could not match the top pair in the final sixteenth but held third. UTOPIAN close up stalking the pace a bit off the rail then outside a rival, bid alongside HOG'S HOLLOW on the final backstretch and between foes on the last turn and until past midstretch and weakened late. PORFIDO (CHI) was in a good position stalking the pace inside, fell back some leaving the final turn and lacked the needed response in the stretch.
