**Footnotes**

OH RIGHTY had good early speed a bit off the rail, dueled inside, fought back on the turn and into the stretch, inched away under urging a sixteenth out and proved best. BULL RING stalked inside while pulling some, bid between horses into the turn then outside the winner, could not match that one in the final sixteenth and just held second. BARON VON RED bobbed at the start, chased inside then a bit off the rail, swung out into the stretch and gained the show late. PRIVATE BOUNTY stalked outside then went four wide leaving the backstretch, bid three deep on the turn and into the stretch, weakened some in the final furlong and just lost third. LEAD BLOCKER prompted the pace outside a rival then three deep between foes into the turn, stalked off the rail on the turn, angled in some into the stretch and weakened. FULL EFFECT a bit slow to begin, settled off the rail then just off the fence on the turn, came out in the stretch and improved position. NISUS stalked between foes then outside, continued three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch and weakened. WHAT'S FOR DINNER four wide early, stalked outside then three deep, continued off the rail into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SO TOUGH broke inward and slowly, pulled his way between horses to stalk the pace and was in tight into the turn, came out into the stretch and had little left for the drive. HOLLYWOOD MOGUL settled outside then off the rail, dropped back into and on the turn and was done early. BARON VON RED and NISUS wore calks.
