Footnotes

CRESTATORRE stalked inside, came out into the stretch, bid alongside a rival in midstretch, took a short lead, kicked clear under urging and held. CLOCKER MOMENT chased outside, moved up four wide on the turn and into the stretch and finished with interest. FATHER PABST stalked off the rail, came out three deep into the stretch, split rivals in deep stretch and was edged for the place. CUT N' DEAL had good early speed and dueled inside, kicked

clear on the turn, fought back in midstretch and weakened late. AHUALULCO chased outside then off the rail, angled in and moved up leaving the turn and lacked the needed rally. OUTTA SPLASH hopped in a slow start, settled outside then off the rail, came five wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. WARREN'S DA MAN settled off the pace inside, came out in the stretch and improved position. P THIRTY EIGHT broke a bit slowly, settled a bit off the rail, split horses a half mile out and was not a threat. NARANJO settled a bit off the rail on the backstretch and turn and was not a threat. JUST JUMPED IN stalked outside a rival or off the rail, steadied between horses leaving the turn, dropped back and weakened. BELLAGIO ROAD dropped back outside then off the rail, came three deep into the stretch, came out again in the drive and lacked a further response. SIBERIAN RUBLE dueled outside then alongside a rival, dropped back on the turn, drifted four wide into the stretch and gave way.
