**Footnotes**

SPEAKING OF TIME unhurried well off the rail early, split rivals four wide on the turn, bumped lightly with GOLDEN GENES in the stretch but closed gamely under urging to get up late. GOLDEN GENES, saved ground to the stretch, came out, bumped with the winner in midstretch but also closed willingly between foes late. SALTY STEPH forced the pace four wide on the backstretch and three deep on the turn, took a short lead into the stretch, inched away in midstretch but was overtaken late. ALESSANDRIA outside GOLDEN GENES on the backstretch, went between rivals on the turn but lacked the needed late response. RENKANT dueled off the rail early and between rivals to the stretch and weakened. DIANE G was close up five wide on the backstretch and four wide on the turn, then dropped back. MUGSY was off a bit slowly, came off the inside on the backstretch, went four wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. BOLGERS HOSTAGE set or forced the pace inside, dropped back into the stretch and weakened. RAVEONCEE settled off the rail, angled in for the turn but was outrun. HIGHER prompted the pace between horses on the backstretch and into the turn, dropped back on the bend and had little left for the stretch. A claim of foul by the rider of the runner-up against the winner for alleged interference in the stretch was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled the light contact between the two did not warrant a disqualification.
