CAPITANO tried to rear and was off behind the field, angled in outside a rival then settled inside, rallied along the rail under urging in the stretch and gamely prevailed. FITZ FLAG (ARG) pulled his way between horses then stalked inside, moved up leaving the backstretch, came out into the stretch, bid four wide in deep stretch and continued willingly. SKYWALKER RED angled in and dueled outside a rival, found the rail on the first turn, dueled inside on the backstretch, inched away briefly on the second turn, battled between horses past midstretch and was outfinished. PRIVATE CHEF broke slowly and was squeezed back, saved ground off the pace, swung out into the stretch and finished with interest. COLONIAL REIGN stalked the pace inside then between foes leaving the backstretch, bid outside the leader leaving the second turn, gained a short lead, was between horses past midstretch and was outfinished. TRICKY TABOO chased three deep then outside a rival, split foes leaving the second turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the necessary response. SPANISH HIGHWAY dueled inside then outside a rival, dropped back on the second turn, drifted four wide into the stretch and weakened. SUBLET (FR) was pulled up shortly after the start and vanned off.
