KING RED sped to the early lead off the rail then dueled outside a rival, was floated out a bit into the stretch, took the lead, inched away in the drive but could not hold off the winner. THEATRICAL PRO stalked outside then alongside a rival, came out in the stretch and edged foes for the show three deep on the line. CRANKY JACK a bit slow to begin, moved up between foes then chased inside, came out nearing midstretch, split horses in deep stretch and was edged for third between rivals. KIM'S LEADING MAN went up inside to duel for the lead, came out a bit into the stretch, angled back in and was outfinished for a minor award. ISLE OF PRADO settled off the rail then three deep, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. MILTY WAY chased off the rail then briefly between foes, angled in some down the hill and weakened in the stretch. ZING ZING broke a bit slowly, settled off the pace inside, came out in upper stretch and did not rally. Rail on hill at 14 feet.
