DISTORTED DAVE pulled a bit and stalked inside then just off the rail, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch, gained the lead outside foes in midstretch and won clear under urging. BIG MAN HAS A SIGN sped to the early lead, set the pace inside then dueled along the rail, fought back in the stretch, could not match the winner in the final furlong but gamely held second. INDIAN FIREWATER broke in a bit, stalked outside a rival then bid alongside the runner-up on the backstretch and second turn, battled between horses in midstretch and bested the others. TIME FOR ATONEMENT chased outside a rival then off the rail, came out some into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. JAIRZIHNO (GB) broke slowly, settled outside a rival to the stretch and did not rally. BRADIO STATION squeezed a bit at the start, settled inside chasing the pace, continued along the rail in the stretch and was not a threat.
