Footnotes

TAKE A YARD was taken in hand after the start, chased slightly off the rail around the first turn and down the backstretch, angled outside on the second turn, came into the stretch four wide and rallied in the middle of the course in the final furlong to gain the lead and draw clear in the late stages. CAUSEITHERTZ was reserved while chasing off the rail down the backstretch, moved closer on the second turn, came into the lane three wide, rallied through the stretch drive but had to settle for second best. TAP IT IN dueled on the inside down the backstretch and around the second turn, led the way into the stretch and gradually weakened on the inside in the final furlong. SQUAD chased on the inside around the first turn, angled off the rail down the backstretch to chase three deep, rallied between horses into and through the stretch and was edged for the show. ONE NATION was three wide into the first turn, moved up entering the backstretch to duel for the lead on the outside of TAP IT IN, continued to press that one into the lane and weakened through the stretch drive. RACHELS MOON angled to the inside around the first turn, chased on the inside down the backstretch and around the second turn, and was unable to mount a rally in the lane. GAME A. P. prompted the pace on the outside around the first turn, stalked the dueling leaders between horses down the backstretch, began to weaken on the second turn and fell back through the stretch.
