ENTABENI dueled inside a rival, inched away on the turn and held on gamely under some left handed urging. MADELINE RUBY chased between horses then outside, went three deep leaving the turn and into the stretch and finished willingly. WANELL broke out a bit, settled off the rail then angled in leaving the backstretch, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch and bested the others. MICHAEL'S KISS had good early speed and dueled outside the winner, stalked on the turn, angled in nearing the stretch and weakened. GRANDPA'S LEGACY chased outside then off the rail, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MALIBU MISCHIEF stalked off the rail then between horses into and again leaving the turn and weakened in the stretch. SLEWS COPY hesitated then wheeled at the start and lost the rider. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the start before ruling SLEWS COPY was the cause of her own trouble.
