DANZING TRIBAL pulled his way along a bit off the rail then stalked inside, slipped through along the fence into the stretch, gained the lead, kicked clear and proved best under a left handed tap of the whip and a brisk hand ride then a long hold late. DERIVE stalked outside then three deep on the hill, came out five wide into the stretch and gained the place late. UNCLE GREG pulled his way between horses and was in a bit tight on the hill, chased inside, came out into the stretch and rallied between horses for the show. THERMAL WAVE also pulled early when a bit off the rail, steadied in tight off heels after a quarter mile, came out leaving the hill and six wide into the stretch and just missed third. SWEET MAKER chased between rivals, waited behind horses nearing the main track crossing, came out three deep into the stretch and was outfinished for a minor award. IMAGE AND LIKENESS had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away briefly off the rail into the stretch, was outside the winner in upper stretch and weakened in the final furlong. BISHOP OF DERRY cut the corner at the right hand curve and chased five wide, angled in alongside a rival, came out four wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late response. VALIANT WONDERBOY pulled toward the inside then stalked off the rail, continued outside the winner leaving the hill, came out four wide into the stretch and weakened. CEE'S CLOSING TIME pulled between horses then chased outside, went four wide on the hill and six wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BARTOK'S BANKER had speed off the rail then dueled outside a rival, drifted three deep into the stretch, dropped back, drifted inward in the drive and weakened. Rail on hill at zero.
