TAP IT LIGHT stalked inside then a bit off the rail, bid alongside a rival to take the lead into the stretch, inched away under urging in deep stretch and held gamely. RENDEZVOUS chased outside a rival then three deep on the final turn, came four wide into the stretch and finished with interest. EAGLE POISE pulled his way along inside then came out leaving the first turn, took the lead in the stretch the first time, set the pace a bit off the rail then inside on the final turn, fought back off the fence in the stretch and held third. PHILATELIST stalked outside a rival or off the rail, went between horses leaving the last turn, came three deep into the stretch and was outfinished. QUINDICI MAN chased outside a rival then inside, came off the rail in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SNOWMASTER settled off the rail then outside a rival, came out in the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. UNUSUAL SUSPECT saved ground off the pace, went around a rival on the second turn, continued inside on the backstretch and final turn, remained along the fence in the stretch and was not a threat. HIGH COURT DRAMA (IRE) between foes early, took the lead and set the pace inside or a bit off the rail, relinquished command in the stretch the first time and stalked inside, was pulled up on the clubhouse turn and vanned off.
