CHURCH CAMP stalked inside then a bit off the rail, continued outside a rival on the second turn, bid three deep leaving that turn and into the stretch, gained the lead nearing midstretch, was between foes a sixteenth out and inched away under urging. BURG BERG pulled a bit and chased inside, inched forward on the second turn and was in a bit tight a quarter mile out, came out into the stretch, bid three deep at the sixteenth pole and continued willingly but could not match the winner. JAX EL broke out and bumped a rival, had speed between horses then angled in, set the pace inside, fought back leaving the second turn and into the stretch, angled off the inside in deep stretch and came back to edge a rival for the show. BRIECAT stalked outside a rival then off the rail, bid between horses and put a head in front leaving the second turn, fought back while drifting inward in the stretch and was edged late for third. ASH ZEE chased three deep leaving the first turn then off the rail, came three wide into the stretch and did not rally. SANDI'S READY bumped at the start, pulled and drifted out into the first turn, chased off the rail, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. I CAN HEAR came out on the first turn, split horses into the backstretch, stalked outside a rival, dropped back just off the fence on the second turn and weakened.
