FORESTRY had a rail trip stalking the pace, slipped through while brushing with SEA TWISTER in midstretch under left handed urging, gained the lead a sixteenth out and proved best. SEA TWISTER, sped to the early lead, set the pace off the rail, drifted in a bit and brushed the winner while fighting back in midstretch but could not match strides late. FUTURAL, bobbled at the start, was outrun off the rail early, came five wide into the stretch and just got the show. LOVE THAT RED, a bit slow into stride, went four wide between rivals on the backstretch, continued close up between foes on the turn, then weakened in the stretch and just lost third. O'REY FANTASMA chased the leader six wide on n the backstretch and five wide into the turn, continued four wide on the bend and weakened. SEA CZAR had brief speed between horses, dropped back and also weakened. TREASURE HUNT, raced close up five wide between rivals to the turn, continued three deep between foes and dropped back. DOMINATION, stumbled slightly at the start, also was close up between horses, dropped back on the turn and gave way.
