JOHAR taken in hand leaving the gate and unhurried while saving ground, launched rally on final bend, swung out, forced five wide into the lane while circling foes, powered to the front and accelerated away impressively. DARK SORCERER (GB) settled off the leaders while saving ground, between foes and inside the winner on the final turn, angled out a bit and closed determinedly from outside to gain the place. SAPHIR INDIEN (GB) advanced from along the rail on the backstretch, lacked room behind rivals from quarter marker until passing midstretch, angled out, found room outside and finished willingly. TELL THEM NOTHING tugged himself into a dueling position from between foes on the backstretch, continued on same path and gained a slim advantage into the stretch and battled gamely to the wire. HAMMER IT HOME three wide early and later caught four wide around the second turn and into the lane, then weakened a bit in the drive. WESTERN STRANGER quickly stepped to the front and angled in to secure the rail, dug in gamely when challenged before retreating in the final sixteenth. DAILY SPORT forced the pace on a three wide path into the backstretch and to the second turn before tiring through the drive.
