Footnotes

FARAH LOVE stalked the pace outside a rival, came out into the stretch, gained the lead nearing midstretch and pulled clear under some urging. KISSING GIRL (ARG) allowed to settle off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and just got the place. PARTY PIRATE sped to the early lead, cut the corner at the right hand curve then angled in down the hill, set the pace inside, fought back in midstretch, could not match the winner and lost second late. MISS EXPENSIVE (ARG) chased between foes then outside a rival down the hill, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. MOVING EXPERIENCE (IRE) was in a good position tracking the pace along the inside, continued on the rail in the lane and did not rally. ABBEY BRIDGE off a bit slowly, settled outside chasing the leader, continued three deep down the hill and four wide into the stretch and also lacked the necessary response. VICTORIA'S GARDEN well placed stalking the pace a bit off the rail, angled in down the hill, came out a bit into the stretch, was between horses in midstretch and weakened.
