SASSOU four wide early, was fanned wider into the first turn, chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail, moved up inside leaving the second turn, came out into the stretch, gained the lead outside the runner-up past the eighth pole and held on gamely under urging. LIBERIAN FREIGHTER stalked a bit off the rail, bid alongside a rival to gain the advantage into the stretch, fought back inside the winner through the final furlong and continued willingly to the wire. BRIAN THE BOLD came off the rail and chased outside a rival then off the inside on the second turn, went three deep into the stretch and picked up the show. UNUSUAL TREASURE pulled inside early then drifted out into the first turn, angled back in and chased inside, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. ONE ON THE HOUSE three deep between foes early, was fanned out into the first turn, chased outside a rival or a bit off the rail and weakened. HERBIE LOVE saved ground off the pace, continued inside in the stretch and did not rally. CALIFORNIA FLAG sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside to the stretch and weakened. WAAFI between horses early, was fanned out into the first turn, chased outside a rival or a bit off the rail, dropped back on the backstretch and also weakened.
